Four-Legged Workers in Istanbul Airport

Airports are very busy places. Many workers help everything run well. Istanbul Airport is one of the busiest airports in the world. Last year, about 76 million people used this airport. Because of this, the airport needs many workers. In 2024, it hired five new workers. But these workers are special. They have four legs and soft fur—they are dogs!

Istanbul Airport started a "therapy dog team." These dogs walk around the airport with their trainers. Their job is to help travelers feel calm and happy. People can pet the dogs and play with them. The dogs are official workers. They even have

uniforms. On their uniforms, it says “Pet Me.” The dogs work from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and they take turns each day.

Before starting their job, the dogs trained for one year. This helped them get used to the airport and stay safe. They began working in February. Kuki, a gray dog with curly fur, is the team leader. He works hard but also likes to rest. Another dog, Alita, is very good at helping people relax. Many visitors enjoy meeting them, and the airport wants to have more therapy dogs in the future.

Move With the Beats

Music helps us exercise, and doctors say there are two main reasons for this. First, music distracts us. When we listen to a song we like, our brain listens to the music and forgets about the hard work. For example, after you exercise for 20 minutes, your body might feel very tired. However, you may not feel the pain right away because the music is in your ears. Because you are thinking about the song and not your tired legs, you can exercise for a longer time.

Second, music motivates us and gives us energy. Happy and fast songs also make us feel good. When we feel happy, we have more energy to keep moving. According to Dr. Costas, the best music for a workout is not too fast and not too slow. Usually, songs with 120 to 140 beats per minute (BPM) are the best choice. This is because most people want their heart to beat at this speed when they are working out.

Choosing the right song can change your workout a lot. For

example, Lady Gaga’s “The Edge of Glory” is 128 BPM, and “Push It” by Salt-N-Pepa is 130 BPM. These songs are perfect for exercising because they have the same speed as your heart. On the other hand, slow songs are not good for the gym. A song like Adele’s “Make You Feel My Love” is only 72 BPM. This kind of slow music makes you want to relax or even take a nap. In short, music is a great tool for your body. If you choose the right songs with a fast beat, you can have a better and longer workout.
